USATF-NJ LDR Committee General Meeting Report September 13, 2017

The LDR sport Committee had our last meeting May 18, 2017. Our Next meeting will be 7PM Monday, September 25, 2017 at the Madison Area YMCA, 111 Kings Road, Madison, NJ.

- The May meeting elected the LDR Sport Committee which took office on July 1, 2017. The LDR Committee expanded with the inclusion MUT and Cross Country Chairs and vice Chairs.

With the exception of the LDR Division Chair and the Masters vice Chair all positions have newly elected members. The eleven LDR sports committee members are in eight different USATF NJ Clubs.

- In 2017 the LDR Committee tried several new initiatives in our Grand Prix.
 - o The Weekend of March 25/26 we had a kickoff weekend with three 700 point category 3 events in the South, Central and North of the state.
 - o We had the President's Cup 5k in June as a Coed Team Championship. This was a Team event separate from the Team Grand Prix. The September meeting will review this to see if it is something that we want to continue in the future.
 - o The Shades of Death Half Marathon on October 8th will be a 500/700 point Wild Card Event again this year.

- We have had the following Championships in 2017 Indian Trails 20k Clinton Country Run 15k Newport 10k Fred D'Ellia 10k New Milford 5k Fitzgeralds Lager Run 5k Midland Mile The 5km Cross Country Championship in Natirar Park

- Remaining Championships in 2017 (All Divisions unless noted) Newport Liberty Half Marathon, September 17th Little Silver 5k, Women's Championship, October 1st The 8km Cross Country Championship, Deerpath Park, October 22nd Giralda Farms 5k, Masters Men's, November 12th Ashenfelter 8k

- This year we have had USATF Officials at all of our Championship Events.

- The LDR Committee has sent out seven surveys to our members with regard to our championships and events in 2017. We have had over 2,000 responses to all the surveys to date. This data will be reviewed and we should have good feedback from our members on or events. •

The LDR committee has also been keeping a year to year analysis of the Championships to review participation rates of the teams. (attachment) • The LDR Championship Bid form is being finalized and will be posted shortly.

Track & Field Report

New Jersey Track & Field had another very successful outdoor season this year. The Open & Masters Championships were held at The Peddie School in Hightstown on June 16th & June 17th, the USATF-NJ Junior Olympic meet was held on Sunday 6/11 in Plainfield and The NJ International meet was also at the Peddie School on 7/1. Going forward having these 3 meets close together or in succession Terry suggested the idea of having a “Track Week” type of flow to keep interest going. There was the usual series of meets put on by the New Jersey Striders, The Shore A C and The Millville Track Club also put on a series. And the season isn’t over yet as there is a field event series coming up in September and October at Christen Brothers Academy in Lincroft and information can be found on Associations Track & Field calendar. Because of the difficulty finding a site for the steeplechase for the State meet that event was held in conjunction with a meet right here at Monmouth University on June 14th with 9 athletes competing.

Because the hammer requires an ultra safe and strict venue we weren’t able to have the event this summer but will be back here at Monmouth on 10/1 for that event.

We had many of our state’s athletes open and masters athletes compete on the national and international level this summer with great results by Harry Nolan and Tony Plaster in New Zealand, Mark Williams and Michael Kish in Canada and Neni Lewis setting 3 American records in the weight, super weight, and ultra-weight event.

Robbie Andrews and Erin Talcott competed in London at the World Championships and native New Jerseyite Ajee Wilson set an American record in the 800 this year and medaled in London. The track and field committee had 2 meetings since our last general meeting with another one scheduled for Thursday October 12th at the Madison Area YMCA. You are all invited to attend that meeting as we are very excited to announce that we are in the process of planning our State indoor meet to be held at the Ocean Breeze facility in Staten Island in February, in conjunction with the USATF-NY indoor meet. We are hashing out the details with the NY Association to possibly have a dual meet between the two associations. Having this meet set up this far in advance should help to make it a very successful and well attended event and hopefully set the stage for more inter-association events.

Ron Salvio - RACE WALK REPORT 9/13/17

7 Association Championships were/are being held in 2017 and will again be held in 2018. (3k track indoor; 5k and 1 hour track outdoor; 5k, 10k 15k and 20k roads).

On April 2017 New Jersey (Freehold Area Running Club) hosted the National Masters 20k Champs. and in July New Jersey (Shore A.C.) hosted the National Open 10k Champs. We still have National Masters 20k Champs. awarded for 2018 and will be considering bidding on the staging of additional National Open and Masters Championships for 2018 through 2020.

Dates remaining for this year are:

Sept 17 (Sun) NJ Open and Masters 15k, Whiting 10:00am (FARC)

Nov 12 (Sun) NJ Open and Masters 5k, Whiting 10:00am (FARC)

Individually and Team wise our Association has been a dominating force on the national level at all the National Championships conducted across the country highlighted by our Erin Taylor-Talcott and Susan Randall comprising 2/3rds of Team USA at the inaugural Women's 50k IAAF World Championships in early August over in London.

Most important issues to be addressed:

- A. Increasing participation
- B. Lack of certified judges
- C. Loss of youth/JO walkers reaching High School

New Programs:

We have instituted use of "pit Lane" at events to encourage new walkers and training for our Junior/Youth walkers.

We have purchased racewalknj.com but need a web designer and or web master to help.
