## FACILITY INFORMATION

**Track:** All Weather 8 lane Mark 3 encapsulated rubberized track

**Field:** Dual brushed concrete Shot and Discus circles

- Dual Long & Triple Jump pits with Mark 3 encapsulated rubberized surface
- Javelin: Mark 3 encapsulated rubberized approach, grass landing
- Spikes: 1/4" or less
- Stadium Capacity: 1,700
- Timing: Lynx, provided by Ed & Marcia Scullion
- Free parking in lots north of stadium
- No alcohol permitted in the stadium
- The stadium complex is a "SMOKE FREE ZONE"
- Coolers are permitted
- Please remove all garbage from your area before you leave.
- Trash bags available at the registration table.
- Concessions available on site.
- Medical volunteers and/or Stockton College of NJ trainers will be stationed at locations in the competition area.

## FACILITY RESTRICTIONS

Track & Field areas are off limits to all non-competitors at all times. Coaches, parents, or individuals other than meet staff will automatically disqualify their athlete from competition if found on the track. The press box and computer area is off limits to all except meet officials and designated personnel.

## CONCESSIONS

Food, drinks and USATF Region Championship apparel will be on sale throughout the meet. No clubs or individuals will be permitted to sell concessions within the Richard Stockton College Campus.

## ENTRY

Top 4 in each event at Association Championships will advance to Region 2 Championships. The host association may advance up to six. **Athletes must complete their entry form and pay their fees at their Association Championship Meet.** Each entry must be appropriately filled out, including your 2007 USATF Membership Number. All entries must come from the Association Youth Chair or representative. Individual entries will not be accepted.

## COACHES MEETING

## AWARDS

USATF Junior Olympic Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Places, ribbons for 4th, 5th & 6th places. Awards will be available for pick-up 30 minutes after the final results are posted.

## CHECK-IN

- Calls will be as follows: 1st Call, 2nd Call, Final Call. The Clerk of Course will officially close the event no sooner than 5 minutes after the final call.
- In both Track & Field events, when the first call is made, athlete must report to the check in tent at the East end of Stadium complex.
- If an athlete is in another event (track or field) a coach or parent may check-in that athlete. That athlete must report no later than the third call.
- Unless checking in an athlete who is competing in another event, no coaches or parents will be permitted within the check-in/clerking area.
- Athletes who have checked in will not be permitted to leave the check-in area.
- After the third/Final call and athletes have been moved for lane and hip assignments, the event will be closed. If an athlete has not reported by this time he/she will be scratched. No other athletes will be permitted to compete.
- Upon closing of a semi-final track event by the clerk of course, those semis having eight (8) or fewer contestants will be passed on to finals. In such cases, only athletes properly checked into the event by the clerk of course prior to closing the semi will be allowed to compete in the final. All finals will be conducted as published in the official order of events.
- Approximate time from first call to event on track will be 45 minutes. All athletes must listen for the announcements.

## RELAYS

Relay teams must submit a USATF Relay Roster (declaration) Form at their Association Championship Meet. This form must be forwarded to the Region Meet. **Teams without relay declarations at the Region Meet will not be allowed to run - NO EXCEPTIONS.** All relay team members (including alternates) must be declared at the Association Meet and must be listed on the USATF Relay Roster Form. **Athletes not on the form are ineligible to run on that relay.** Athletes must also be entered into the meet and an individual entry form must be submitted. All relay team members must wear identical uniforms, top & bottom.

## IMPLEMENTS

Personal implements may be used but must be weighed prior to competition each day - time & place to be announced. The "loss of identity" rule applies to all implements except javelin & pole vault. Pole-vaulters must provide their own vaulting poles. All competitors must use blocks and batons provided by meet management.

## PROTESTS

Protests must be filed within 30 minutes of posting of final results. There will be a \$50.00 cash fee required when filing a protest. Protests must be in writing with the specific rule(s) in question stated. The fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

## ADVANCEMENTS

The top 3 finishers in each individual event advance. Multi-Events advance top 2; 3<sup>rd</sup> place must meet standard to advance. Move-up for 4<sup>th</sup> place finisher meeting Junior Olympic Standard if there is an open spot. It is imperative for athletes/coaches to notify the advancement area if they are not advancing. All advancement (including move-up) must be completed and paid prior to leaving the region meet. The USA Track & Field National Junior Olympics will be held July 24-29 in Walnut, CA. **Sub-Bantams will not advance.**

## DIRECTIONS

**From Northern NJ:** Take Garden State Parkway South to exit 44; turn right onto Port Republic Road; go 1/2 mile. Turn left onto College Drive. Parking will be on your right in 1/2 mile to athletic field house.  
**From Camden / Philadelphia Area:** Take Atlantic City Expressway to exit 12, turn left. Proceed straight past light at Route 30/White Horse Pike. At next light turn right onto Jim Leeds Road. Go 1 mile & turn left onto College Drive. Follow 1 1/2 miles to athletic field house.  
**From Southern NJ:** Take Garden State Parkway north to the Atlantic City Service area (mile post 42.5). Exit behind the service area to Jim Leeds Road. Turn left on Jim Leeds Road. Go 1 mile & turn right onto College Drive and proceed 1/2 miles. Parking available on the left near the athlete field house.
