## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

*Individuals:* Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States, and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF Rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the Sub Bantam, Bantam and Midget divisions may compete in a maximum of three events, including relays. Competitors in the Youth, Intermediate, and Young divisions may compete in a maximum of four events, including relays.

**All athletes must be 2011 USATF members in good standing.**

**HOW TO ENTER THIS MEET:** Entries only through online registration at [www.usatfnj.org/youth](http://www.usatfnj.org/youth). **NO mail in entries.** **14 years and under athletes** who qualify for this meet must enter after their Preliminary Qualifier Meet is posted online and no later than Wednesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 11:59pm. See [www.usatfnj.org/youth/](http://www.usatfnj.org/youth/) for a list of Prelims.

**All 15-18 year old athletes** must register online by Wednesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 11:59pm.

**Events not contested at Preliminaries:** Athletes competing in TJ, HJ, Discus, Javelin, PV, 4X800m relay or any of the Hurdles must register online by June 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59pm in order to compete at the Association Championships.

**THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup> REGISTRATION DEADLINE.**

**Steeplechase, Pole Vault & Multi events** (Triathlon, Pentathlon, and Decathlon & Heptathlon) will not be contested at the Association Championships. Athletes in these events automatically advance to the regional meet.

**ALL:** Only coaches can register team athletes online who qualify for this meet. Unattached minor athletes (7-17) must have a parent or guardian register them online. All 18 year old unattached athletes may register themselves.

**FEES, PRE-ENTRY ONLINE ONLY:** \$6/Individual Event; \$24/Relay team. **AGE GROUPS** determined by year of birth as above. Athletes who are still eighteen (18) years of age through the final day of the National JO TF Championships shall be eligible to compete in the Young Men's/Young Women's Division through that meet – as per USATF Rule 240 (1) (c). **Relay Teams:** Only registered 2011 USATF-NJ member clubs may enter relay team. All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership.

**PROOF OF AGE:** All participants must have proof of age verified in their USATF membership profile in order to enter this meet. All entrants without current proof of age verified in their profile must submit a copy of their age verification (birth certificate, passport, certified baptismal record, driver's license, or U.S. government identification) by email to [services@usatfnj.org](mailto:services@usatfnj.org) in order to be able to advance to the association meet. We will not be processing verifications after May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011 so don't wait to send it in!

**AWARDS:** USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three individuals and the top three relay teams in each event of each age division. Ribbons issued for 4<sup>th</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> place individuals and relays.

**ADVANCEMENTS:** The top 6 individuals and relay teams in each event of each age division will advance to the USATF Region 2 Championships to be held July 7-10 at California University PA. More info [www.usatfnj.org/youth](http://www.usatfnj.org/youth)

**All advancement/entry for the USATF Region 2 Championships must be completed & paid for within 72-96 hours online at [www.usatfnj.org/youth](http://www.usatfnj.org/youth).** National Championships are July 26 - 31, 2011 at Cessna Stadium, Wichita State University, Wichita, Kansas. Top 5 athletes at Region 2 Championships will qualify for the National Championships. **IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN:** 8am Saturday and Sunday. Location will be posted at stadium entrance.

**EVENT CHECK-IN:** Athletes must check in at for their events 45 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

**COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS:** All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$10. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes beginning at 8am.

**EVENT RESULTS:** During competition, event results will be posted. Event results will also be posted at [www.usatfnj.org/youth/](http://www.usatfnj.org/youth/) within 2 days after the completion of the meet.

**PROTESTS:** There is a \$50 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Meet Director at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced. Protests are escalated from the Meet Director to the Games Committee and then to the Jury of Appeals. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld. **Judgment calls may not be protested.**

**DIRECTIONS:** The track is at 1001 Sixth Ave, Asbury Park, NJ 07712. High School is at 1003 Sunset Ave, Asbury Park. **From Garden State Parkway going North or South:** Take exit 100A or 100B to merge onto 66 East. Follow 66 East to Asbury Circle, to Route 35 North. At 2<sup>nd</sup> light turn right. Proceed 1 mile to Asbury HS; track is located behind HS building.
